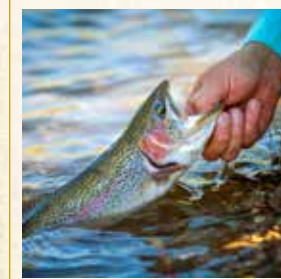
The Dining Hall

Grayling Creek runs through the ranch, and the Madison River is just around the bend. With four Blue Ribbon fly fishing rivers within 30 miles of the ranch, you might want to spend a week. If you want to float a river, we'll make the arrangements with one of our local guides for you. We have fishing equipment and lessons available for you at the ranch.



The Extras

You can grab one of our mountain bikes and take a tour of the ranch or ride off into the mountains. We have fly fishing lessons and equipment, horseshoes, volleyball, a basketball hoop, and an assortment of lawn games.

Yellowstone

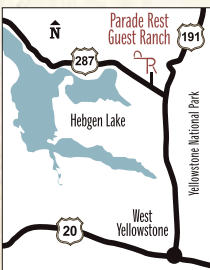
